This Deed made the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November in the year 1867, between James S. Borden and Mary S. Borden his wife of the first part and Robert M. Soler of the second part, Wherefore that the said parts of the first part in consideration of the sum of Sixty dollars to them in hand paid by the said part of the second part, do grant unto Robert M. Soler party of the second part, all their right title and interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, containing thirty Acres to the same more or less, and bounded as follows: Commencing at the point at the head running parallel with Seacoek Swamp where the line of Williams Beales crosses said land and running along said road in a southerly course to a line Branch at Hark Corner, thence down said Branch, which divides & runs the land of James S. Borden and Mary S. Borden his wife, thence said land Branch unites with another larger Branch, thence down second Branch which divides said land from the lands of Washington Chapman, thence said Branch unites againe to Jamison Branch, thence up Jamison Branch which divides said land from the lands of Patrick Jones to William Beales line, thence up said Beales line to the road at the Commencement. And the parties of the first part, do further warrant and defend a few bays right to the party of the second part, and his heirs forever, as Witness the following signatures and seals the day and date above written.
