This Deed made the 25th of April, in the year of our Lord, Eighteen hundred and thirty eight, between Elbert W. Ferguson and Sarah C. Ferguson his wife, of the County of Santhampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Benjamin E. Pope, of the same County and State of the other part; Witnesseth, that the said Elbert W. Ferguson and Sarah C. Ferguson his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred & four Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin E. Pope, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain & sell, unto them the said Benjamin E. Pope, his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land, situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Santhampton and parish of Saint Luke's, containing by a late survey twenty eight acres, it being lots No. 5 in the division of the Land of Matthew Dickson d.d. lying near Norton's Shop, including a portion of the domain Land, and drawn by said Elbert W. Ferguson & wife, and bounded as follows; Beginning at a post in the Southern boundary of the Land belonging to the Rail road Company, a corner for the Land of Nathl. Jones and wife, being lot No. 4 in the division aforesaid, thence along their line S. 18° E. 122 poles to a post near a small person named Mrs. a corner in the line of Henry S. Ferguson & wife, being lot No. 1 in the said division; thence along their line S. 69° E. 34 poles to a corner in Mrs. Neal's line at the road, thence along her line on the East Side of the road S. 25° W. 92 poles to a pine corner for James J. Garden, thence along his line to his corner, in the line of the Rail road Land; thence along the line of the Rail Road Land to the beginning. To have and to hold the above described tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto them the said Benjamin E. Pope, his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Elbert W. Ferguson and Sarah C. Ferguson his wife, for themselves, their heirs, Executors and administrators, do hereby Covenant and agree, to and with the said Benjamin E.
