Ferguson his wife, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia, of the two parts, and Benjamin E. Pops, of the same County and State of the other part; Washington, they the said Elbridge W. Ferguson and Sarah C. Ferguson his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred & four Dollars, to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin E. Pops, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hereinafter bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain & sell unto them the said Benjamin E. Pops, his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land, Street lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and parish of Seaford Sutton, containing by a late survey twenty eight acres, & being lot No. 5 in the division of the said Matthew Dicks d.d. lying near Newmarket Sept., including a portion of the lower land, and drawn by said Elbridge W. Ferguson & wife, and bounded as follows; Beginning at a post in the Southern boundary of the land belonging to the Rail road Company, a corner for the said of Elbridge Jones and wife, being lot No. 4 in the division aforesaid, thence along their line S. 18° E. 132' poles to a post near a small person named Tra. (a corner in the line of Henry J. Ferguson & wife, being lot No. 1 in the said division; thence along their line S. 69° E. 30' poles to a corner in Mrs. Neals line, at the road, thence along her line on the Bay side of the road at w^e. N. 92' poles to a post or corner for Jeremy Jardon, thence along his line to his corner, in the line of the Rail road land, thence along the line of the Rail road land to the beginning.
