Clements then his or her Share to be applied to the Support of his or her Children, if no Children due to the Support of the Survivors, and at the death of W^m. G. T. Clements Senior, as aforesaid then, the said tract of Land to be divided equally between Ada S. Clements, Edgar S. Clements, George W. Clements and Josephine. But should either of the parties die during the said W^m. G. T. Clements lifetime leaving children, then his or her Share to be equally divided among the Survivors, it being the intention of the grantor Martha V. Griggard that she and her said Share to equally divide at the said Senior's death, among Ada S. Clements, Edgar S. Clements, George W. Clements and Josephine Clements or the Survivors of them and the issue of such as may be dead, the Children of any who may have died taking his or her parents Share, and the said Martha V. Griggard with herby warrant and demands unto the said W^m. G. T. Clements such title as has been conveyed to her from W^m. G. T. Clements by Deed dated the 28th day of March 1868.
