forty-eight, between James R. Ricketts and Annie S. Ricketts his wife, of the one party, and Williams  
Stone & H. C. Ellis of the other party, witnesseth, that the said James R. Ricketts and Annie S. his  
Wife, do grant and convey unto the said Williams H. C. Ellis, all that certain piece or  
parcel of Land with its appurtenances, Situated in the County of Southampton, State of  
Virginia, near Tuckahoe, Va. and bounded as follows; on the North by Carey's bridge  
1868 road, and the Lands of Mary Viets and Jeptha B. Viets, on the East by the Churchfield and  
Jerusalem roads, and the Lands of Jeptha B. Viets and Williams L. Williams, and the South,  
by the Land formerly owned by Joseph Pepe and the Land of Moses James, and on the  
West, by the Land of the said Moses James and the Land of George H. Viets. In Sum,  
to Secured unto Simon Stone of the City of Norfolk, the payment of the sum of One Thousand  
Dollars, as evidenced by a certain promissory Note of even date with these presents, made  
by the said James R. Ricketts and A. G. Millhado and signed by them by their parlour-ship  
names Ricketts & Millhado, whereby they promised to pay six months after the date thereof  
to the order of Caroline G. Ferguson, at the Exchange National Bank of Norfolk, Va. the sum  
of One Thousand Dollars, without defalcation for Value received, which said Note was afterwards  
endorsed over by the said Caroline G. Ferguson to the said Simon Stone, as also to Secured any  
and all rents that may be given in respect of the land above mentioned.
