Sykes for Thirty three Dollars and 10/100 due and due May 15th 1868, and bank for Forty five \$5/100 Dollars, dated & due May 15th 1868, to Daniel H. French, and it is hereby covenanted and agreed between the parties, to this Deed, that a sale shall take place, when either of the parties shall be ready, for cash, after giving fifteen days Notice of hand, and the proceeds after paying all debts of this Deed, shall be applied to the payment of the above described debt and interest, and the balanced pay ~~and~~ to the said Samuel B.
