This Subt made the 31st day of December, in the year of our Lord, eighth hundred
and Sixty Seven, between Miles Story of the County of Southampton and State of
Virginia of the one party, and Edwin R. Story of the said County and State
of the other party, Witnesseth, that the said Miles Story for and in Considera-
tion of the Sum of Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00) to him in hand paid
by the said Edwin R. Story, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
Have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and
sell unto him the said Edwin R. Story, his heirs, and assigns forever, all
his right, title, interest, or estate which he inherited from his son Joshua
S. Story died in and to one certain tract or parcel of Land situated, lying,
and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Peter's
containing by estimation two hundred and twenty four acres, be the same
more or less, and bounded by the Lands of Sir H. Bishop, Arthur Dicks
heirs and others; it being the same tract, or parcel of Land which the
said Miles Story sold to the said Edwin R. and Joshua S. Story, as will
appear by his Subt bearing date January 22nd 1867, he have
and to hold all the right, title, interest, or Estate of him the said
Miles Story in and to the above described tract, or parcel of Land
and premises, with its appurtenances, unto him the said Edwin R.
Story, his heirs and assigns forever; and the said Miles Story, for him-
self, his heirs, Executors and administrators, doth hereby Covenant and
agree with the said Edwin R. Story, his heirs, Executors, administrators
and assigns, that he agree by these presents to warrant and forever
defend all his said right, title interest, or Estate in the tract of
Land aforesaid against the claims or demands of all and every
other person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof the said
