This Deed made this 1st day of June in the year One Thousand eight hundred and
 Sixty eight, between Charles Bondbrew, Grantor, of the one part, and Edwin R. Story
 Trustee, of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said Charles Bondbrew doth grant, unto the said
 E. R. Story Trustee the following property, viz: the whole of my tract of Land on which
 I reside, lying & being in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia containing one
 hundred & Ten acres more or less, through which the Sea Beach and R. R. Road passes,
 bounded by the Lands of Joshua Drake, Jas H. Holt (heirs &c) also old Bay Road,
 Thru feature Ridge & junctions &c. The Trustee to secure the payments of the follow-
 ing debts due to Parker S. Story, one Bond of One hundred and twenty seven
 Dollars and Eleven Cents bearing even date with this Trusty deed. But if it should
 be necessary to sell the said property for the payment of the said debts, the said
 Trustee is to give twenty days notice by advertisement at some or more places
 nearest the property, and sell the property for cash to the highest bidder, or so

 balance to the payments of the aforesaid Bond & Interest & the surplus if any
