

This Deed Made the 10th day of June in the Year 1868, between John B. Stephenson of the first party, and Mills E. Stephenson of the second party; Wethersfield, that in Consideration of Mills E. Stephenson Carrying out the provisions of the last Will & Testimony of William G. Stephenson deceased in relation to the Messes' & Stephensons family Conveyance, the said John B. Stephenson doth grant unto Mills E. Stephenson & his heirs title & interest in a certain tract of land for a home lying in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, Containing One Hundred Acres, by the same more or less, and bounded as follows, On the North by Seaville Swamp, on the East by the lands of Allen Edwards, on the South east by the lands of Allen Edwards, & on the South, and West, by the lands of Alfred P. Stephenson, etc. witness the following signatures & seals, this the 10th day of June, 1868.

Stephenson, before a Justice of the peace, admitted to record, & Stamps of the Internal Revenue of the United States, to the amount of two dollars, being affixed thereto & duly cancell'd.

Know all men by these presents, that I, Nathaniel T. Fells of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, to the first party, for and in Consideration of the sum of Three hundred & fifty Dollars, lawful money of the United States to me in hand paid, or before the insuring & delivery of these presents by Benjamin A. James of the same place of the second party, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained & sold & by these presents do grant & convey unto the said party of the second party, his Executrix, Administratrix & assigns, Thirty Barnells of land, bounds of Fells, now growing & estimated to be my portion of the said growing Corn & Hedges, also, Sixty five hundred weight of Lard Cakes, Lard Cakes now growing, & estimated to be my portion of said Cakes crop. Seven sheep, one Bushel Pease, & two Calves, to have and to hold the same unto the said party of the second party, his Executrix, Administratrix & assigns forever. And I do for myself my heirs, Executrix & Administratrix, Conveying & agree to & with the said party of the second party to warrant & defend the sale of the said goods & chattels hereby shall unto the said party of the second party, his Executrix, Administratrix & assigns, against all & every person and persons whomsoever, in dispute whereof it shall happen, before my hand & seal this the eighteenth day of July, One Thousand Eight hundred & forty eight.
