Shands, of the Village of Jerusalem, in the County of Southampton, and State of Virginia, in said District, has been duly appointed Assignee in said Matter. Now Shureford S. Benjamin B. Foster, Register in Bankruptcy, of said District by virtue of the authority vested in me by the 14th Section of an Act of Congress, entitled, "An Act to establish a Uniform System of Bankruptcy, throughout the United States," approved March 2d 1867, do hereby convey and assign to the said William B. Shands, Assignee, as aforesaid, all the Estate Real & Personal, of the said William W. Briggs, Bankrupt, aforesaid, including all the property of whatever kind of which he is proprietor, or in which he was interested, or entitled to have on the 27th day of February A.D. 1868, with all his Suits, Books and papers relating thereto, excepting such property as is exempted from the operation of this Assignment by the provisions of said Bankrupt's Act. I do here and to hold all the foregoing premises to the said William B. Shands, and his heirs forever. This Sub made this 27th day of August 1868, between George S. Bernard Inslee of Anne E. Everett of the one parts and John Merwin of the other, Witnesseth that whereas said Everett did, by deed dated May 8th 1868 and of record in Southampton Co. Va. grant with general warranty to said Bernard, a certain tract of Land Situate in said County, described in said deed as containing "about two hundred & nine acres" & "adjoining the Land of Francis S. Ridley, Harrison S. Tapp, H. S. Barrons & others," but which contains only two hundred & seven acres according to the Survey made by E. A. Feltow Surveyor of the City of Petersburg as appears by a plat of the Land made by said Surveyor dated May 1st 1868. (Which accompanies this Sub as a part thereof. On Sub to secure the payment of a debt of \$300 in said deed described, upon certain terms therein set forth, and whereas the said Everett failing to pay the said debt, said Bernard as regards by R. E. Kelly the Creditor named in said deed which is here referred to as a part of this deed, to execute his, the said Bernard's trust, and whereas said Bernard being so required acting in pursuance of said deed, having duly advertised the Sale of said property, did sell the same at public auction to the said John Merwin for the sum of four hundred
