Personal, of the said William W. Briggs, Bankrupt, aforesaid, including all the property of
whatever kind of which he is possessed, or in which he was interested, or entitled to
have on the 27th day of February A.D. 1868, with all his Books, Books and papers
relating thereto, excepting such property as is exempted from the operation of this Assignment
by the provisions of said Fourteenth Section of said Act. To have and to hold
all the foregoing premises to the said William B. Shands, and his heirs forever. In Testu,

That Deed of Assignment, Under the Seal of the United States District Court for the District of
Virginia, Was presented by William B. Shands, Assigned, and admitted to record. In Testu:

This Deed Made this 27th day of August 1868, between George S. Bernard trustee of Ann E.
Everett of the one part and John Morris of the other; Witnesseth that whereas said Everett
did, by Deed dated May 8th 1868 and of record in Southampton Co. Va. granted unto grantee
warrantly, to said Bernard a certain tract of Land situate in said County, described in said
Deed as containing "about Two hundred & nine acres" & "adjoining the Lands of Francis S. Ridder,
Harrison & Fife, H. P. Barnes & others," but which contains only Two hundred & Seven acres
according to the Survey made by E. A. Fellow Surveyor of the City of Petersburg, as appears
by a plat of the Land made by said Surveyor dated May 1st 1868, (which accompa-
nies this Deed as a part thereof.) In trust to secure the payment of a debt of \$300.
in said Deed described, upon certain terms herein set forth, and whereas the said Everett
failing to pay the said debt, said Bernard as required by R. E. Webb the Creditor
mane in said debt which is here referred to as a part of this debt, to execute his, de-
sire to have said Bernard bring the same to record in the office of the Clerk of
said County, and whereas said Bernard being so required acting in pur-
suance of said debt, having duly advertised the sale of said property, did
sell the same at public auction to the said John Morris for the sum of four hundred
