



This Deed made this 15th day of August in the year One Thousand Eight hundred and
Sixty eight, between James J. Darden & Sarah E. Darden his wife of Southampton County
Virginia, and Harrison P. Pope of the same County & State. Witnesseth: That in Consideration
of the sum of eight hundred and Sixty six dollars & forty eight cents the said J. J. Darden
& S. E. Darden his wife doth grant unto the said H. P. Pope all of their entries situated
in a certain piece of Land which was cut off the original Survey Tract Number
to the Newson Dwelling house bounded by the lands of H. P. Pope, J. J. Darden
and Coswell Horrell's Esq. Land as Thos B. Horrell run the line & divided it,
containing One hundred & four acres more or less, and the said J. J. Darden
conveying to whomsoever all the right title & interest in said piece of Land that
