Assignment of Bankrupt's Effects.

Now Therefore I, Benj. B. Foster, Register in Bankruptcy of said District, by virtue of
the authority vested in me by the 14th Section of an Act of Congress, entitled, "An
act to establish a Uniform System of Bankruptcy throughout the United States,"
approved March 3^d 1867, do hereby convey and assign to the said Joseph B. Trined,
assignee, as aforesaid, all the estate, real & personal, of the said John D. Glantz,
Bankrupt, aforesaid, including all the property of whatever kind of which he is
proprietor or in which he was interested, or entitled to have on the 18th day of
September A.D. 1868, with all his debts, books & papers relating thereto, excepting
such property as is exempted from the operation of this assignment by the provisions
of said 14th Section of said act. Do stand And to Stock all the foregoing
promises to the said Joseph B. Trined, and his heirs forever, In Trust,
to hold, for the use and behoof, with the powers, and subject to the
conditions and limitations set forth in said act.

consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars, paid by the said John S. Spring, and
granted unto the said John S. Spring a tract of Land containing by estimation one
hundred and eighty acres, be the same more or less, and bounded by the Lands of
J. S. Soler on the East, and formerly the Woodson tract on the South, and the
Mill pond to Hord's Land on North. The said William J. Williams and Mary
his wife do relinquish and all right, title, or claim, in said tract of Land.
