This Deed made this 11th day of November in the year one thousand eight hundred & sixty eight between Benjamin B. Kendrick and Joseph H. Barham of the first part, and John A. Sackler, of the other part; Whereas as follows; Whereas the said Benjamin B. Kendrick did by Deed of Gift recorded in the Clerk's Office of Southampton County, on the 20th day of May A.D. 1866, among other things, grant and convey to E. W. Mapsonburg as Trustee, a certain tract of Land which is described in the said deed of Gift in the following words to wit: All that tract of Land on which the said B. B. Kendrick now resides, lying near English's Point, supposed to contain six hundred and fifty acres, more or less, and bounded by the Land of Mills A. Smith, William Tyler Bryant, Corwith Bryant & others; - Which said tract of Land was conveyed to the said Mapsonburg in Trust to receive the payment of a certain debt due to the said Joseph H. Barham; and whereas the said Kendrick has, with the approbation and assent of the said Barham, this day bargained and sold the said tract of Land and the same to the said Sackler; Now this Deed of Bargain & Sale, that the herein described to the said John A. Sackler; Now this Deed of Bargain & Sale of the said Benjamin B. Kendrick & Joseph H. Barham for and in consideration of the sum of Three thousand and two hundred dollars, paid to them by the said John A. Sackler; the receipt of which sum is hereby acknowledged, duly grant and convey to the said John A. Sackler, all of the said tract of Land hereinbefore described.

The said Joseph H. Barham grants and conveys to the said Sackler only such right, title and interest as he may have in and to the said tract of Land by virtue of the said Deed of Gift. And the said Benjamin B. Kendrick grants and conveys the said tract of Land to the said John A.
