Whereas A. W. Norfolk did on the 23rd day of April two thousand eight hundred and sixty six, execute a Deed of Trust whereby was duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of Saukrapun County, conveying to Luther B. Edwards as trustee certain parcels or tracts of real property situated in the aforesaid County, and by authority of which deed, a Sale of said property was made the first day of October the thousand eight hundred and sixty eight, and said A. W. Norfolk having for the said of three thousand four hundred dollars, transferred the purchase of two of the aforesaid tracts of Land, to wit; the one adjoining the Village of Franklin, on the West Side and adjoining the Blaster to wit; the one adjoining the Lands of John Suther and others, it being the tract in which the said Norfolk resides at the time of the above mentioned conveyance and in which the road named and which was first purchased by him of the said Norfolk of E.
