This Indenture made this 30th day of September, Eighteen hundred and Sixty eight, between Mary
R. Barrett in her own right and as Executrix of Richard Barrett deceased, of the one part, and
John M. Robinson, President of the Seaboard and Roanoke Rail Road Company, for and in
behalf of said Company of the other part; witnesseth; that the said Mary R. Barrett, for and in
consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars, to her in hand paid by the said John
M. Robinson, for and in behalf of said Company, and before the execution and delivery
of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further considerations
hereinafter stated, has granted and leases, and doth hereby grant and leases, for and during
the full term of Ninety nine years, and so long thereafter as the said Company may think
proper to use the same. Under the said John M. Robinson for and in behalf of said Company
a right of way, over and through her, the said Mary R. Barrett land, in the County of
Southampton, at or near Readings Inlet, to the landing on the Blackwater River, for the
use, benefit and enjoyment of said Company, this way to be wide enough to allow of the
freight and easy passage of the teams of said Company, and not to be used for other
purposes, and the said Mary R. Barrett, for herself, her heirs, her executors and admo-
nitors, will convey to and with the said John M. Robinson and his successors, that
the said right of way shall run and extend in the direction as shall be indicated by
said John M. Robinson or by his authority agents or agents, beginning at or near
the Point, between the Inlet and the bridge over the Blackwater River; but if the said
Company shall ever have after, for the space of five years consecutively, cease to use
the track and right of way hereby granted, then, the said tract, except parts, and with
out prejudice to her right to the said Mary R. Barrett, her heirs or assigns. The said
Company hereby covenants to erect, maintain and keep in repair suitable gates
at the points where the said road may enter and leave the said field, whenever
required so to do by the said Mary R. Barrett, with a suitable opening to the
