This Indenture made this 20th day of September Eighteen hundred and Sixty eight, between James W. Lawrence and Virginia A. his wife of the one part, and John M. Robinson, President of the Eastern & Roanoke Rail Road Company for and in behalf of said Company, of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said James W. Lawrence, and Virginia A. his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Seventy five dollars to them in hand paid by the said John M. Robinson, and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, and do hereby grant unto the said John M. Robinson for and in behalf of said Company, for and during the full term of twenty years from the date hereof, a right of way over and through that tract or parcel of Land, Situate in the County of Southampton, at or near Pleasant's Dept, adjoining the Land of Mary D. Barrett, and formerly a part of same, known to the County roads and the Blackwater River, and known the bounding of the Eastern & Roanoke Rail Road, (which said tract is the same tract was parted out by the said J. W. Lawrence from Richard Barrett) to the Steamboat Landing
