This Indenture made this 26th day of September Eighteen hundred and Sixty eight, between James W. Gardner and Virginia A. his wife of the one part, and John M. Robinson, President of the Seaboard & Roanoke Rail Road Company for and in behalf of said Company, of the other part, witnesseth, that the said James W. Gardner, and Virginia A. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Seventy five dollars to them in hand paid by the said John M. Robinson, at and before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, and do hereby grant unto the said John M. Robinson for and in behalf of said Company for and during the full term of twenty years from the date hereof, a right of way over and through the tract or parcel of land, situate in the County of Southampton, in or near Pleasantville Dept, adjoining the lands of Mary R. Barrett, and formerly a part of said land, between the boundary line and the Blackwater River, and between the boundary and the Seaboard & Roanoke Rail Roads, (which said tract is the same that was purchased by the said J. W. Gardner from Richard Barrett,) to the Steamboat Landing
