than twelve feet wide. And the said Jones W. Lawrence for himself, his heirs, executors and
administrators, and for and in behalf of the said Virginian & his wife, doth covenant to
and with the said John M. Robinson, that the said Grants and Roads the Rail Road Company
shall at the expiration of the said twenty years, enjoy the said right of way, for so long
time of twenty years, without any other consideration than the consideration hereinbefore
expressed, which is below viz'd the consideration for the several terms of twenty years; and
the said Jones W. Lawrence for himself, his heirs, executors and administrators, and
for and in behalf of the said Virginian & his wife, doth covenant that the said right
of way, shall run and extend in the direction as shall be indicated by the said John
M. Robinson, or by his authorized agent or agents. And the said John M. Robinson,
covenants that where the said way shall run and lead the said lot, said shall
be erected by the said Company, provide the said Jones W. Lawrence shall well
own the said lot, and that whenever the said tract shall have been finally recorded,
and the bills taken up, and the said right of way, shall no longer be necessary for
the purposes of said Company, the said right of way shall revert to the said Jones
