 and with the said John M. Robinson, that the said Blackwater and Roanoke Road Company,
 should at the expiration of the said twenty years, enjoy the said right of way, for a term
 term of twenty years, without any other consideration than the consideration hereunto before
 expressed. And it is likewise the consideration for the second term of twenty years, and
 the said James W. Lawrence for himself, his heirs, his Executors and administrators, and
 for and in behalf of the said Virginia A. his wife, doth covenant that the said right
 of way, should run and extend in the direction as shall be indicated by the said John
 M. Robinson, or by his authorized agent or agents. And the said John M. Robinson,
 covenants that should the said way shall enter and leave the said lot, said shall
 be erected by the said Company, provided the said James W. Lawrence shall not
 use the said lot, and that whenever the said tract shall have been finally removed,
 and the hills taken up, and the said right of way, shall no longer be necessary for
 the purposes of said Company, the said right of way shall revert to the said James
