Whereas Jacob Lewis by his Deed of Trust dated the 6th day of November 1866,
 did in order to Secure to Willis W. Lawrence the sum of fifteen hundred dollars,
 as security for part, money and W^m W^r Briggs the trustee named in said Deed, a tract
 of Land in Southampton, containing Two hundred and fifty six acres. more or less, and
 adjoining the lands of Peter Scott, Samuel Fisher, Edwin Hicks and others; and
 whereas the said Jacob Lewis has paid the said sum of money and all interest
 due thereon. Wherefore, This Deed made the 18th day of February 1868, between
 the said W^m W^r Briggs as trustee as aforesaid of the first part, Jacob Lewis
 of the second part and the said Willis W. Lawrence of the third part, doth
 stipulate, That the said W^m W^r Briggs as trustee as aforesaid and in consideration
 of the premises as also of two dollars to him in hand paid, (and by
 and with the consent of said Willis W. Lawrence, signified by his being
 a party hereto,) doth remise and release unto the said Jacob Lewis & to
 his heirs & assigns forever, the lands aforesaid & all the appurtenances.
