 A. Hart and Harriet M. Hart of the one part, and G. H. Musgrave of the other part,
 W^tthepiece, that for and in Consideration of the sum of One hundred dollars to them in hand
 paid at the Sealing & Delivering of these presents, the said E. Edwards A. Hart and Harriet
 M. Hart his wife, hereby grant, Convey, and release unto the said G. H. Musgrave, all their
 right, title and interest in the following described part of Land, included in the following
 boundary lines. Commencing at a persimmon tree about one hundred yards east of the said
 Musgrave's gate, thence due South to the branch, thence down said branch to the stream, thence
 up said stream until it reaches G. H. Musgrave's low at the North side of said stream, thence
 along said low to the road, thence along said road until it reaches the point at which the
 present line diverges to the North of the road in G. H. Musgrave's field, thence along this
 line to the said E. A. Hart's gate, thence along the road in a westerly course to the place
 of beginning. The whole containing about fifty acres, to the same more or less, found under
 the hands the day and year above written.
