

Mill draw & two acres at the North end of the draw, for the sum of One hundred & forty Seven dollars & fifty Cents, & also the "Enright Tract" of Seven hundred & Ninety three acres, less the Twenty acres attached to the Mill as above named, for the sum of Nine hundred & Thirty dollars, which sum have been remitted according to the terms of sale. This Act therefore made this 18<sup>th</sup> day of January 1869, between the said John R. Kelly, as aforesaid, of the one part, & the said William H. Daugherty, Joseph G. Brumfield & Cecil C. Vaughan of the other part, W. Daugherty, the said John R. Kelly, as aforesaid, in consideration of the said sum of Ninety seven dollars & fifty cents as aforesaid, has given with Special warranty, unto the said William H. Daugherty, Joseph G. Brumfield & Cecil C. Vaughan & to their heirs & assigns forever, the two parcels of Real Estate aforesaid, that is to say, First the Mill pond & Mill site & the premises & rights & all its appurtenances, including two acres at the North end of the Mill draw & Twenty acres at the South end of the draw, now situated on the West side of Hottoway River, in the County of Southampton & adjoining the "Enright Tract", herein after named. Secondly, the Enright Tract, containing 793 acres, (Ninety of which are cut off as aforesaid,) situated also on the West bank of Hottoway River, in Clark County, & bounded & described, as follows: Beginning at high water mark on Mill pond, @ corner for C. Brumfield & O. Johnson, year @ small white Oak, thence his line S 78° E. 11 poles to @ red Oak, thence S 58° E. 13 poles to @ pine & hickory, thence E. 76° E. 14 1/2 poles to an Oak Stand, thence E. 17° E. 96 poles to @ Hickory, @ corner for said Johnson, thence S 56° E. 48 poles to @ pine, thence S 47° E. 9 poles to @ Pine, thence S 39° E. 18 poles to @ Spruce stand, thence S 59° E. 17 poles to @ dead Oak, thence S. 67° E. 13 poles to @ Spruce stand, thence S. 76° E. 10 1/2 poles to @ spruce Oak, thence S. 68° E. 8 poles to @ Maple, thence S. 42° E. 18 poles to @ Pine, thence S. 45° E. 38 poles to C. Brumfield & O. Johnson corner, near @ point in Cott's line, thence along Cott's line N 27 1/2° E. 161 1/2 poles to @ Spruce stand @ corner, thence S. 46° E. 128 1/2 poles to @ Maff's Standing in @ branch @ corner for James M. Cullis, thence his line down the run of the branch to the River, thence up the edge of the River to the Creek, thence up the Creek & Mill run to an Island, thence around the Island on the edge of the low grounds to @ Pine 2 poles below the said dam. Thence parallel with the said arrow the flood gate hole about 8 poles to @ small red Oak, thence across the end of the land to the Mill pond, thence along the draw & up high water mark of the Mill pond to the Mill Site. Thence along the draw & up the Mill pond up high water marks to the beginning containing 793 acres, including the Island lying between the two Mill dams & two Islands near the Mill Site, & exclusive of the low grounds which, (is part of which was not Surveyed,) but which are all still unoccupied, together with all & singular the privileges and appurtenances belonging to said lands & Mill & the wharves of the purchase. Many there remain due, & payable as follows: to wit; the sum of \$443. 33 1/3, due twelve months from the 16<sup>th</sup> of December, 1868, and @ like sum of \$443. 33 1/3 due eighteen months from same time, & @ like sum of \$443. 33 1/3 due twenty four months from same time, & all carrying interest from the said 16<sup>th</sup> day of December, 1868. (Wherefore @ sum is retained by the said John R. Kelly, as aforesaid, on said lands for the payment of said several sums of money, & the right reserved to proceed to collect the whole amount, which delayed to be made for thirty days in any payment) Will sign the following signature & seal.
