

This Deed made the 14th day of April 1868, between James Rows & Sallie Rows of the one part, & R. A. Brister of the other part, Witnesseth, That the said James Rows & Sallie Rows, do grant unto the said R. A. Brister, the following property to wit, One Certain tract of Land containing about One hundred & Sixty acres, be the same more or less, to have the following debts, viz: One debt due Robert W. Scraps, for Two hundred dollars, due the first day of March, Eighteen hundred & Sixty Seven. One debt due Mary Jane Harris, for fifty five dollars, due the first day of February, Eighteen hundred & Sixty Seven. One debt due Deborah Harris, for fifty five dollars, due the 1st day of February, Eighteen hundred & Sixty Seven.
