Bordwell, and right, title & interest, in & certain piece or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, containing by estimation Eight (8) acres, & bounded as follows, to wit: by the land of Mrs. Emily Brink, & on the South & East by the Lands of James S. Bordwell, to him, & his heirs forever. As Witness the following Signatures & Seal.

Bordwell & Mary S. Bordwell his wife, do grant unto the said Emily Brink, all their right, title & interest in & certain piece or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, containing by estimation eight acres, be the same more or less, & bounded as follows, to wit: by the land of Emily Brink, on the North by the land of James S.
