five lbs. brown sugar, thirty pounds of Coffee & one Bed & furniture. The said  
John Whitehead further agrees, to allow the said Rebecca A. Turner, to retain what  
property she has before Marriage, after Marriage is solemnized, in gold, silver,  
allowing her full discretion to make what dispositions of said property, she may  
deem proper. The said Rebecca A. Turner, further agrees, to say no title need  
claim, to give to the property real or personal, belonging to the said John  
Whitehead, in the event of his being the largest heir, & that the Marriage  
is solemnized, outside of what is enumerated in this agreement.

affixed our seals, this thirteenth day of February, 1869.

Whereas Wm. W. Draper of Massachusetts County by his Deed of Trust dated as or about  
the day of 1865, and duly recorded in Massachusetts County, & which was  
destroyed by the burning of the Clerk's Office of said County, in February 1866,  
conveys unto John R. Kelly, the Trustee therein named, a tract of Land in the  
County of Southampton, containing by relations nearly two acres, more or less, &  
adjoining the Lands of General Cheppin, Jacobus's Isle & Joseph's Isle, &  
which said was then recorded in Southampton County - and whereas the said John  
R. Kelly as Trustee aforesaid by Consent of said parties, made sale of said land  
before the Court house door of Massachusetts County on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of October 1868,  
after due notice, & at such sale the same was purchased by Alexander H. Ashburn,  
(the Creditor named in said Deed) for one hundred & sixty dollars, which  
in specie, & whereas by the directions of said Alexander H. Ashburn, a Deed  
is directed to be made to said Wm. W. Draper, who has become substituted  
as the purchaser of said Land by the Consent of said Ashburn.  
This Deed therefore made this 5<sup>th</sup> day of February 1869, between the said John R.  
Kelly, Trustee as aforesaid of the one part, & the said Wm. W. Draper, of the other  
part, Witnesseth, that the said John R. Kelly as Trustee aforesaid, in consideration  
of the premises, does grant unto aforesaid Draper, unto the said Wm. W. Draper,  
& to his heirs & assigns forever, the Land aforesaid sold as above set forth.
