property she has before Marriage, after Marriage is Schoenoyek, in foddin, allowing
him full discretion to make what disposition of said property, she may
deem proper. The said Rebecca A. Turner, further agrees, to lay no claim now
or hereafter, to none of the property real or personal, belonging to the said John
Whitelocke, in the event of his being the longest living, & that the Marriage
is Schoenoyek, outside of which is unprovided in this agreement.

of the month of October 1868, and duly recorded in Yarmouth County, P which was
destroyed by the burning of the Clerk's Office of said County, in October 1866,
conveyed unto John R. Kelly, the sum of One Thousand Dollars, a tract of Land in the
County of Southwicks, containing by estimation Ninety Two acres, more or less. P
adjoining the lands of Edmund Chappell, Gardner & Taylor & Heydon & Bradburn,
which said land was duly recorded in Southwicks County - and whereas the said John
R. Kelly as Trustee aforesaid by reason of his poverty, made sale of said tract
before the Courtland date of payment, to the said Alexander H. Abbott, before
the 15th day of October 1868, after due notice, & it stands to the said was purchased by Alexander H. Abbott,
(the creditor's servants in said suit) for One hundred & Sixty dollars, which

Kelly, Trustee as aforesaid of the one part, & the said W^m P Draper, of the other
part, witnesseth, That the said John R. Kelly as Trustee aforesaid, in consideration
of the sum of One Thousand Dollars, doth grant with special warranty unto the said W^m P Draper
& his heirs & assigns forever, the said aforesaid tract as above set forth -
