

This Deed made the 31st day of January in the year Eighteen hundred & Sixty nine between James R. W. Penfret, that in Consideration of the sum of Eight hundred & twenty five dollars paid by the said Penfret & Bro. to the said James R. Person, the said James R. Person & Ann E. Person his wife do grant unto the said Geo. W. Turner & James E. T. Turner of the firm of Turner & Son, at their infant in Corkeas Creek or parcell to Davis by me & bounded as follows: So wit: Commencing in the center of the road known along the line between P. Person & the Nelson Church line to the corner opposite @ White Oak, a side low distance about one hundred & Eighty three yards, known along the line of Chopp. trees in a Northly direction to a corner few low distance about three hundred & forty yards, known along a line of Chopp. trees in a Southly direction to the center of the road through a Court yard, known along the road in a Southly direction to the place of beginning, containing ten acres, more or less. The right & title to which, the said James R. Person & Ann E. his wife do look themselves, their heirs Executors & to defend against any & all claimants. W. stamp the following Signature & Seal.
