Davis & Eliza Jane his wife of the one part, & William Whitehead & Ann his wife of the other part, Whereas that for & in consideration of the ten acres of Land mentioned below, the said Joseph B. Davis & Eliza Jane his wife do bargain, grant & convey unto the said William Whitehead the following tract or parcel of Land lying in Southampton County & containing by estimation forty acres, to the same more or less, bounded & described as follows, Commencing at 53 poles from the corner line of C. F. Ricks on the road running N. 24° E. 111 P. to John Dearborn's line & bounded by the Lands of John Dearborn on the East & by the Lands formerly belonging to the heirs of Edwin Ricks, etc. in the South, all of it lying East of the road leading from Petersburg to Jerusalem; and for & in consideration of the said forty acres, of land, the said William Whitehead & Ann his wife to grant, sell & convey unto the said Joseph B. Davis, the following parcel of Land, lying in Southampton County, bounded & described as follows, & containing by estimation ten acres, viz; on the North by Joseph B. Davis land, on the East by the road leading from Jerusalem to Petersburg, running from said road at West corner, beginning at an Oak, next a Pine, & Walnut, & forked Pine and large branch, running on the edge of this branch to the intersection again, again with the line of Joseph B. Davis. And the said Joseph B.
