This Deed made & executed this 14th day of December 1867, between Joseph G. Crumpler and Elizabeth F. Crumpler his wife & Sillitum A. Gay & Elizabeth R. Gay his wife, parties of the first part, & Cecil C. Vaughan, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, of the second part, Witnesseth: That in consideration of two hundred dollars, to them paid, the said Joseph G. Crumpler & Elizabeth F. his wife, & Sillitum A. Gay & Elizabeth R. his wife, do grant, sell & convey, to the said Cecil C. Vaughan, all their right, title & interest, in & to certain lot of land in the Village of Franklin Southampton County, State of Virginia, formerly owned by William C. Gay dec'd. Said lot contains one acre, more or less, lying on the North side of the Seaboard & Annapolis Rail road, commencing at the East corner of the lot formerly made by Robert G. Edwards, dec'd. Thence along the said lot line two hundred & two feet, to the road or street leading from the Jerusalem road (running by the Store house built & formerly owned by A. W. Norfleet & which was sold by said Norfleet to William Sharps), to the Blackwater River, thence along said road or street to the Old road leading from Franklin Sept. to the County Bridge across Blackwater River, two hundred twenty three & half feet; thence along the edge or line of aforesaid old road to the said Road two hundred & nine feet, thence along the said Road back one hundred & fifty eight feet to the first station.
