Judkins, all of the County of Southampton, State of Virginia, of the second part, witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of three thousand & three hundred dollars, the said Joshua P. Bryant & Mary Ann his wife, do grant unto the said William H. Judkins with his wife Mary Ann all of their right, title & interest in the following real Estate, to wit, a certain tract of land in the County of Southampton, lying on the east side of Notchey Swamp, bounded as follows; commencing at and back in Jack's Branch in Joseph E.
