 the second part, Witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of three thousand & three hundred
 dollars, the said Joshua P. Bryant & Mary Ann his wife, do grant unto the said William
 H. Jenkins with Special Warranty all of their right, title & interest in the following real
 estate, to wit: a certain tract or parcel of Land, in the County of Southampton, lying on the
 east side of Newbury Swamp, bounded as follows: Commencing at and back in Jack's
 Branch in Joseph E. Gillman's line, from thence a line of Mark's tree running in a
 North West direction dividing it from the Land formerly owned by Elizabeth Brinkley,
 & which was sold by the heirs of said Elizabeth Brinkley, to Edward D. the wife of Edward Brinkley
