


Suffolk County to wit, W<sup>t</sup> Luther R. Edwards & H<sup>t</sup> V. Cobb, Justices of said County, do

E. B. Beale, (the teneant,) Eight acres of land & there more, five acres of  
cattle & their increase, forming a ten acre tract of land & about, also all the Cows,  
Cattle, pigs, fowls &c raised on my farm this year 1869, that I am in arrears  
in respect to debts due Beale & Harrison (of Baytins, Va.)  
viz, an open account due 1<sup>st</sup> day January 1869 of One hundred & fifty dollars  
which my hand & seal this 3<sup>rd</sup> day of May 1869.
