

This Deed made this 28th day of February Eighteen hundred & Sixty Nines, between Joseph A. Drury of the first part, & William James of the second, all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia; Witnesseth, That the said Joseph A. Drury in Consideration of the sum of Twenty five dollars to him in hand paid by the said William James, the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges, hereby grants & Conveys to the said William James a certain piece of Land lying near James & Drury's Mill & bounded as follows; on the West by the road running North from the Bridge on the North by the road running East from the Mill on the East by the Land of John Williams & on the South by the Dipper Swamp, the same to his heirs & assigns, more or less, to him & his heirs forever & the said Joseph A. Drury for himself, his heirs, Executors & Administrators doth Covenant by agree with the said William James his heirs &c. That he the said Joseph A. Drury his heirs &c. will forever warrant & defend the right & title to the said William James, to the above said Land, to him & his heirs forever.
