Whereas Allen Edwards of the County of Southampton, by his Sub of Bargain & Sale dated the  
20th day of April 1846, & duly recorded, sold & conveyed unto Robert M. Edwards, for  
the sum of Ten thousand five hundred dollars, the Lands & Plantations on which the said  
Allen Edwards then resided & now resides, containing, Ten hundred & fifty acres,  
more or less, & adjoining the Lands of Richard G. Edwards, Wm. G. Stephenson, Alfred  
S. Stephenson, Frederick C. Johnson & Dr. H. H. Adams, & whereas the said Sale  
was made for the purpose of Cancelling a Debt due by the said Allen Edwards  
to said Robert M. Edwards & also to provide out of the surplus & funds to pay  
towards the Balance due by said Allen Edwards to his wife Margaret C. Sikes.  
And whereas at the April term of the Circuit Court of the County of Jameson, &  
a Term was made in the Cause showing pending of Margaret C. Sikes &c.  
against Allen Edwards &c. in favor of said Margaret C. Sikes against the  
said Allen Edwards her Guardian for \$3184.83 with Interest on \$2816.71  
paid there of from the 14th day of February 1847, still paid. And whereas the  
said Robert M. Edwards desiring to make such settlement of the Matter as was  
unable him to know his part of said Lands, & to set apart that part which is  
to go towards the payment of the Debt due by said Allen Edwards to the said  
Margaret C. Sikes, has now made this Deed, conveying a part of said Land  
for said purpose, retaining the Balance in satisfaction of his own demands  
against said Allen Edwards as agreed on.

This Deed therefore made this 12th day of June 1847, between Robert M. Edwards  
of one part, & James M. McCloskey chosen as trustee, of the  
other part, Witnesseth, that the said Robert M. Edwards does grant with  
general warranty, in consideration of the premises & the sum of two hundred  
dollars payable to said Allen Edwards of \$2250.00 unto the said James  
M. McCloskey trustee as aforesaid, Two hundred acres, more or less,  
being a part of the Lands conveyed by said Allen Edwards to said  
Robert M. Edwards, by Deed of the day of  
as above named, together with the dwelling house & out houses thereon,  
which part now conveyed adjoins the Lands of Richard G. Edwards, Joseph  
Crawell, Samuel J. Harris, Alfred S. Stephenson & Mills C. Stephenson.  
In Trust, & with power to the said James M. McCloskey, trustee as  
aforesaid, to make sale of said Lands twenty conveyed & appurtenances  
at private or public sale, in the best manner he can, & after paying all  
legal charges, to apply the proceeds towards the payment of the Debt  
& Interest due by said Allen Edwards to said Margaret C.  
Sikes as ascertained by said Term. The sale to be made when  
directed by any legal guardian of said Margaret C. Sikes,  
or by herself when she becomes of lawful age, or by any security  
of said Allen Edwards, or his Guardian or Bond.
