Whereas James W. Williams, as Comptroller appointed by a decree of the County Court of Southampton County made at the June Term 1819, in a suit between between Susan F. Gaskins late Williams widow of Spotsley E. Williams dec'd. Francis E. Williams & Partheny his wife & others Plaintiffs and Samuel Kille, Comptroller of, Charles J. Williams, Defendant, has made a Deed to Ego J. Gardner conveying a house & lot in Jerusalem, disingratic in the plan of said Town as sh^d. 1. And whereas do not see any writ or title of the said Partheny wife of the said Francis E. Williams in case the said Susan F. Gaskins, will be entitled to do so or other interests in said house & lot or any part of it, is able finally & forever all doubts or questions upon the subject, the said Francis E. Williams & wife agree to execute this deed.

Not therefore this deed made this 17th day of July 1819, between the said Francis E. Williams & Partheny his wife & Ego J. Gardner, Witness, that for and in consideration of the promise as well as for the further consideration of one dollar, the said Francis E. Williams & Partheny his wife do grant unto general warranty unto the said Ego J. Gardner, all their interest right & title in & to the house & lot above referred to, to wit: the house & lot situated in the Town of Jerusalem, County of Southampton, disingratic in the plan of said Town as sh^d. 1. was formerly owned by Spotsley E. Williams & purchased by him of Dr. Richard Bayley & Ego W. his wife by due records January 20th 1813. Witness the following Signatures & Seals.

Williams & Partheny his wife to be their act & deed, & the said Partheny appears before me, in my Office, & being examined by me privately & apart from her husband, & hearing the said writing fully explained to her, she the said Partheny acknowledged the same to be her act & declared that she had executed it willingly & does not wish to retract it. The said deed is admitted to record. Stamps of the Internal Revenue of the United States to the amount of fifty Cents being affixed thereto, & duly cancelled.

Sudley, all of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia, of the one part, & Miles Horner of the same County & State of the other part, Witness, that the said husband S. Barkard, Charles J. Barkard his wife & Margaret A. Sudley for & in consideration of the sum of One hundred & thirty seven dollars & seventy five Cents to them in hand paid by the said Miles Horner at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, & sold & by these presents do hereby grant bargain & sell unto the said
