Kindred, (Grantee) of the second part, and Benja. B. Kindred of the third part, Witnesses, as follows; Whereas the said Benja. B. Kindred is surely for the said Jno. J. Kindred to a certain grating the galley under Seal due to Joseph H. Barham, for the land of six Acres and Rods, exceeding in the Middle of May A.D. 1811, and the said Jno. J. Kindred is desirous of having the said Benja. B. Kindred, from all loss & damage by reason of his said Suretyship; That this Deed, Witnesseth, that the said Jno. J. Kindred, for & in consideration of the premises, doth grant & Convey to the said D. H. Kindred the following property, to wit; One brown Horse, lately purchased by the said Grantor, of Henry Thomas Barham, One red Cow & Calf together with increase, One buggy, One Cart & wheels, One gold Watch & Chain, the same which belonged to and was formerly worn by my wife; In Witness, to have the said Benja. B. Kindred hatenly paid all loss as above stated. & Witness the following Signatures & Seal.

Briggs Trustee, for that purpose the following property, to wit; all that tract or parcel of Land on which I reside lying in the County of Southampton & containing by Estimation Three Hundred Acres more or less, it being the same tract of Land said Barham purchased of James Dillards - also One Mare, One black Mare, all my Stock of Cattle & Hogs, One Wagon, Two Carts & wheels, farming utensils, household & Kitchen furniture - also all my grating crops of all kinds, consisting of Corn & fodder, Collins & grounds here. & Witness the following Signatures & Seals.
