Dick doth grant with general warranty to the said Thomas Ridley & his heirs & assigns forever, the following tract or parcel of Land, to wit; The tract of Two hundred & four acres more or less, lying in the County of Southampton bounded by the Land of Thos. Ridley, & Garrison off to the East by the Neversink River, together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging, & this Land was this day conveyed to the said Robt. S. Dick, by Sam'l.
