Crumpler, for diverse Hundreds & Fifty four dollars, payable two months from the 20th day of September in the year Eighteen Standards & Sixty Eight with interest from that date & on the payment of said sum to execute & deliver to David Crumpler as good & sufficient Debt with special warranty in few simple for the Lands in the proceedings of said Suit mentioned above of Polly Johnson formerly Polly Purcell deceased in the County of Southampton, containing by estimation One Hundred & Ninety Two & three thirds acres, to the same Negro as before, lying adjacent to the lands of the heirs of John Beakins deceased & the said John Crumpler, and whereby the said David Crumpler has fully paid off said sum to the said C. B. Haydon, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Now I, the said C. B. Haydon, in consideration whereof, & in pursuance of the decree aforesaid, do hereby grant with Special Warranty in few simple to the said David Crumpler, the tract of Land aforesaid.
