Dick of the first part & Elias Morris of the second part, doth bargain & sell to Elias Morris a certain tract or parcel of Land for the consideration of Sixty five dollars, said land lying in County of Southampton & said to contain twelve (12) acres, more or less, and the plantation formerly belonging to James G. Morris & adjoining the lands of Williamson Morris, Harrison F. Fox & Elias Morris, Lenard Beale, and C. John T. Dick & Caroline Dick the wife of the said Dick doth bargain & sell to the said Elias Morris the above named Land, or having forever, for which we the said John T. Dick & Caroline Dick do warrant & defend forever all our rights title & interest in the said Land to the said Elias Morris or heirs forever. Witnesseth we have set our hands & seals this day & date above written in presence of
