Edwards of the aforesaid County & State of the second part, Witnesseth that the said F. de Bordenave doth grant & convey unto the said Luther R. Edwards the following premises property, to wit, the whole of his crop of Sea Islands except two hundred bushels already sold to Elias Harris - Said Sea Islands to be delivered to said Luther R. Edwards at Franklin Depot, as soon as they are fit to be sold after digging; the whole of his Cotton crop, to be delivered at the same place, after picking; and the whole of his Corn crop, to be delivered on his the said F. de Bordenave's farm, and two Mules, two Sows, the other Negro Coloreds. which the said F. de Bordenave purchased from Henry D. Both - For Cash, to Secure the following debt, to wit, One Note of Three hundred dollars due from said F. de Bordenave to Henry D. Both, said Note bearing and given to said Henry D. Both in consideration of purchase of the above mentioned Mules. Witness the following Signatures & Seal.
