State of Delaware the payment of the sum of Negatable Notes drawn  
by the said Edwin Mattson, dated the first day of July 1819, and  
payable to the said Eli Small Jr. by order, unless 3 months after its  
date, being for the sum of Thirty Seven Hundred & ten Dollars. —  
And it is covenanted & agreed between the parties aforesaid, that in  
case of sale the same shall be made after first advertising the  
same, placed & running thereof for ten days, in some newspaper in the  
City of Norfolk, and upon the following terms, to wit; for Cash,  
as to so much of the proceeds as may be necessary to defray the  
expenses of executing this trust & to discharge the amount of  
Money principal & interest, then payable upon the said note; and if  
there be any residue of said proceeds remaining, the same shall  
be made payable at such time, & to be secured in such manner  
as the said Edwin Mattson & his executors, administrators, or assigns,  
shall prescribe & direct, or in case of his or their failure to give  
such directions, at such time & in such manner as the said John  
H. Nash, shall think fit. The said Edwin Mattson, covenants to  
pay all taxes, apportioned, due & charged upon the said property  
hereby conveyed, so long as he or his heirs or assigns shall hold
