This Deed Made this 17<sup>th</sup> day of July A.D. 1817, between John Kavan,  
of the City of Petersburg, of the first part, and Joseph Sticks of the City  
of New York of the other part, W<sup>t</sup>ncipalized that for & in Consideration  
of the sum of Seven hundred Dollars (\$700.) Cash in hand paid by  
Said Sticks to Said Kavan, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,  
Said John Kavan doth grant, with general warranty unto Said Joseph  
Sticks, the following property, to wit: A certain tract of land with  
its buildings, appurtenances, situated in the County of Southampton, Va.  
about 12 Miles North East of Petersburg & within half a mile of  
the public road leading from said Petersburg to Sticksford, containing  
Survey made by E. A. Miller, Surveyor, Two hundred & Seven (207)  
acres, being the same property Conveyed by And C. Everett to  
Geo. S. Bernard by Deed dated May 1<sup>st</sup> 1818, in trust for certain  
purposes herein mentioned & Conveyed by said Geo. S. Bernard, Esq.  
to said John Kavan by Deed dated August 27<sup>th</sup> 1818, Said  
Kavan having purchased said property of said Bernard, Esq.,  
as & also all publice actions had on said August 27<sup>th</sup> 1818, under  
& by virtue of said Deed of Trust from said And C. Everett, whereby  
said Deed, together with a plat of the Land made by said  
Miller, Surveyor, are to record in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of  
Said County of Southampton and are here referred to for further  
more accurate description of the property hereby intended to

This Deed made this 10<sup>th</sup> day of August One Thousand Eight Hundred  
and Sixty Nine before Sylvanus Stines, Commissioner, appointed by Southampton  
County Court at January Term 1818, to sell the land of the late John  
Stines, deceased of the first part, and James S. White of the second part,  
W<sup>t</sup>ncipal, that in Consideration of the sum of Seven hundred & Five dollars,
