hundred & Sixty Nine, between John J. Deyo, C. C. Ferguson, Edwin R. Foy, and
James H. Williams of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the one
part, and Elwin R. Foy of the same County & State of the other part,
Witnesseth that the said John J. Deyo, C. C. Ferguson, Edwin R. Foy & James H.
Williams, for & in Consideration of the sum of One hundred and sixty five dollars,
to them in hand paid by the said Elwin R. Foy at the sealing & delivery of these
present, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained
& sold, & by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Elwin R.
Foy, his heirs & assigns forever, all their right, title and interest in and to
the certain tract of land, situate, lying & being in the aforesaid
County of Southampton & parish of Saint Luke's, containing two hundred and
ten acres, to the same described, and bounded as follows, Beginning at
a rock Oak & pine Stump, @ corner for said Elwin R. Foy, thence along 3rd line
line of Wadsworth's at 8th C. 1st poles to a small black pine another
corner for said Elwin R. Foy, also @ corner for Mariano P. Goy, thence along
the various courses of said Elwin R. Foy's line to the beginning of 3rd line
of a certain tract of land formerly owned by John B. Perkins, containing
one hundred acres, which was sold last December by John B. Perkins Esq.
descendants of said John B. Perkins & purchased by said John J. Deyo,
