This Deed Made the 17th day of November in the year 1818, between Thomas Sadler and Elizabeth Sadler his wife of the one part & Thomas Stewart of the other part, all of the County of Southampton Va. Whereas, that in consideration of the sum of thirty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Stewart the said Thomas Sadler & Elizabeth his wife do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said Thomas Stewart all their rights title & interest in a certain piece of land containing twelve (12) acres, to the same word is left & lying in the County of Southampton Va. and known as the David Sutton's tract & bounded by the lands of Sadler & Alphonso, Solomon & Philbert & Thomas Stewart, to have and to hold the said interests in the said piece of land his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas Sadler & Elizabeth his wife do hereby Covenant & agree with the said Thomas Stewart that they will by their personal power warrant and defend the said Thomas Stewart's rights and claims against all persons whatsoever in Whom Whereof the said Thomas Sadler and Elizabeth his wife has hereunder set their hand and affixed their seals this the day and date above written.
