Barrett, all her right, title and interest, (and Estate for the life only of the said grantor?) either in law or equity, wheresoever said Sarah may have or hold in and to the tract of lands on which she now resides, supposed to contain about two hundred acres, more or less, and bounded by the lands of Messrs. E. Myrick, Caroline Throp and the lands belonging to the heirs of the late George Conitt; It being the said Sarah's day assigned to the said Sarah as dower out of the land of her late husband, Benjamin F. Barrett; the said Lucilius and James to have and to hold the said tract of lands hereby granted, in equal shares to be divided by them at their will and pleasure, unto the said Sarah E.
