

Article of agreement made & entered into this 26th day of September 1817, between Ben
 E. Pfo. & Robert S. Pfo. both of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia,
 Whereas the said Ben E. Pfo has this day sold to the said Robert S. Pfo part of the tract
 of Land to the said Ben E. Pfo, purchased of the late Henry B. Vaughan decd. known as
 the Downing's place, lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by late
 Survey, Nine Hundred & Eighty acres, to w^e the same year or before, beginning
 at a pine standing at the North side of the Road, a corner for Thomas Vaughan & the S. Thorp,
 and Col. Thomas Ridley, known along Ridley's line yearly went to a corner from Thomas East,
 along a line of Chapel tree to a pine at corner for Ridley known still along his line yearly
 until it is registered, corner for Sally Haggard, in Col. Ridley's line, known along his line
 South East to the end of a branch, known also the end of the branch to a pine tree, the first
 known along a line of Chapel & Yorkton trees, South East to the Yorkton trees, known
 along the mill path South East, to St. J. Pfo's line, known along his line, containing a line of
 Maple trees to a pine near an old field, known through old field South East to the
 road, St. J. Pfo's corner in Thomas Vaughan's line, known along the road westward to the
 beginning. This tract of Nine hundred & Eighty acres of land is sold to the
 said Robert S. Pfo, by the said Ben E. Pfo, for the sum of Two thousand Nine hundred &
 thirty five dollars in Gold coin to be paid in the following manner, by the said
 Robert S. Pfo, or his legal representative, the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to be paid in
 Gold coin in 6 months after the first day of January 1818, and the balance to be paid in
 two annual instalments, in Gold coin with interest at the rate of Six per cent, per
 annum, that is, the first deferred payment of one half to be made the first day of
 January 1819, with the interest on the whole amount still owing and so on annually
 until the whole amount is paid, in Gold, with the interest, the said Robert S. Pfo also
 promises & binds himself that in the event, that the Sheriff of Great Western Dist
 Recd. Note within the aforesaid time, to establish & run through said farm
 if this known to any Sheriff or Station or said farm, to the said Robert S. Pfo, bind
 himself his heirs, Executors & Administrators to let the said Ben E. Pfo have
 One hundred acres of land around said Station, at five dollars per acre, to be
 paid in Gold coin when due or his Executors, Administrators or assigns, and to
 pay the said Ben E. Pfo a Due of Bargain & Sale for same, the said Robert S. Pfo
 also promises & binds himself, to let the said Ben E. Pfo have one of the top
 fields to pay his Rents and in few of charged until all the Rent is paid for;
 and the said Ben E. Pfo promising & binds himself his heirs, Executors & Adminis-
 trators, that when the said Robert S. Pfo, his heirs, Executors, Administrators or
 assigns shall have fully paid him the said Ben E. Pfo for the aforesaid Bond and
 promises, according to this Contract, then the said Ben E. Pfo, promises & binds himself
 his heirs, Executors & Administrators, to make the said Robert S. Pfo a Due of
 Bargain & Sale for the aforesaid Land & promising, to let not until the said Robert
 S. Pfo has paid the aforesaid amount of One Thousand Nine hundred & Thirty five
 Dollars, with Six per cent interest from the 1st day of January 1818, to the said
 Ben E. Pfo, his heirs, Executors & Administrators to make the said Robert S.
 Pfo a Due for said Land promising, Not to have & Seals the day 3rd day
 first written
