This Indenture makes this fifteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand
 eight hundred & thirty nine between Joseph Gregory of the Village of Franklin & County of
 Southampton State of Virginia, of the first part, and William Peterson of the same,
 of the second part, Witnesseth that I the said Joseph Gregory of the first part, for
 and in consideration of certain indebtedness to the said William Peterson of the
 second part, to the amount of two hundred & fifty dollars, of \$250.00 I
 have conveyed bargained & sold & by these presents have conveyed, bargained, granted
 and sold unto the said William Peterson, In Trust, to secure the full & just
 payment of the same, the following personal property to wit; One horse &
 buggy, One cart, two cows & two calves, Nine stags, together with all my
 household & kitchen furniture, to have & hold the same for himself his
 heirs & assigns forever, in the default of payment of the said two hundred
 & fifty dollars, the said William Peterson to continue in peaceable possession
 of the said goods & chattels, and the full & free enjoyment of the same forever,
 In Testimony whereof, I have hereunto set my hand & seal this fifteenth
 day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & thirty
 nine, the Year of 1819 bearing date of June 1st 1819, with lawful
 witness from said date.

This Deed makes this the 13th day of August one thousand eight hundred and
 thirty nine, (1819) between William W. Glover of the County of Southampton,
 and State of Virginia, of the first part, and L. C. Pope of the
 same County and State, (Trustee) of the second part, Witnesseth that the said
 William W. Glover, doth grant unto the said L. C. Pope, Trustee, a certain
 tract of Land whereon the said W. W. Glover now resides, lying in the Black
 Water River & adjoining the land of Beddick C. Boyett & James Campbell
 containing thirty (30) acres more or less, In Trust, to secure Beddick
 C. Boyett for the Note of thirty dollars & fifty Cents, (\$30.00) of
 said W. W. Glover, due August 1st 1820 to the said Beddick C. Boyett & James Campbell.
