 of the said W^m H. Griffin & S^t H. Griffin before a Commissioner of
 Deeds for the State of Virginia, admitted to record. Charge of the Clerk of the
 Office of Six dollars, being affixed thereto duly Cancelled.

This Deed made the 31st day of December in the year of our Lord 1818,
 between Drury North of the first part, & James G. Laws of the same part, Witnesseth
 that in consideration of land and affection & for the further Consideration of 100
 dollars to me in hand paid by the said James G. Laws, I do grant unto the said James
 G. Laws, all my right, title and interest in & to certain pieces of, undivided
 lands lying on the Swamp just below Willis Bradshaw's old mill, and bounded on
 the East by said Swamp, on the South by the County road and on the West
 by the lands of W^m J. Dickerson, supposed to be twenty six acres, & my
 interest is two fifths (2/5) of a warrant and forever defend the title by laws
 presently at W^m H. Griffin my hands and seal the day & date above writing.

This Deed made this 1st day of October in the year of our Lord, Eighteen hundred
 & Sixty Nine, between Robert McKendree Barnes of the County of Southampton & State
 of Virginia, of the one part, & Jacob Ferguson of the same County & State of the other
 part. Witnesseth that the said Robert McKendree Barnes for & in consideration of the
 sum of one hundred & seventy dollars paid to Robert M. Barnes & others on the
 18th day of September 1816, by said Jacob Ferguson, as well as by this
 Deed of this date for thirty four acres of Land therein described, which Deed
 is recorded in the Clerk's Office of this County and for the further Consideration
 of the sum of two dollars in hand paid by the said Jacob Ferguson to the
 said Robert McKendree Barnes, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged;
 do the said Robert McKendree Barnes hath granted, bargained, sold & relinquished
 unto the said Jacob Ferguson & his heirs forever, all his right, title
 & interest, in & to the thirty four acres of Land above referred to, & with by laws
 presently warrant and forever defend the same against the claims or demand
 of all & every other person or persons whatsoever. In Witness whereof
