Barkham, did in the 2nd day of August 1819, convey to the said W. W. Briggs, Tracts of Land, lying in the County of Southampton containing by reservation three hundred and fifty acres, more or less, in trust to secure & discharge the said W. W. Briggs by bonds for three hundred dollars, also & with due care to Whitefield for two hundred & fifty dollars due by bonds, being bonds carrying interest from that date, and the said Thos. G. Barkham hath this day paid said bonds in full to the said W. W. Briggs, Tracts as aforesaid. Now this Debt of Bargain & Sale, that the said W. W. Briggs Tracts as aforesaid, in consideration of the payment of the said bonds interest & costs aforesaid, doth convey unto the said Thos. G. Barkham his heirs and assigns, all the right title and interest, which he hath in said Tracts of Land by virtue of the said of bonds above described. Barkham and Virginia & his wife of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia of the first part, and Constant S. Wickham of the City of New York, State of New York, of the second part, witnesses that in consideration of the sum of five hundred and four hundred dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the said Theophilus G. Barkham and Virginia & his wife, do grant unto the said Constant S. Wickham, with general warranty, and that certain tract of Land, with all the improvements thereon, and also the way, straight, spring cypress and appurtenances thereof, situated in the Parishes of Jerusalem and New Franklin and Memphis Parishes, in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia, and bounded as follows; Beginning at the large post in the corner of a land down the Sandy Bay Road, and running in a straight line of 200 rods up to the head of said road, thence up said road 200 rods to the line of John B.
